

Network Visualizer Graph Applet Documentation

The Network Visualizer (GraphApplet) can launch directly from Blanche. But it can't do so without some tweaking on your part. Here are the things you need to do to get the applet to work correctly:

Make sure you have the JDK 1.1.8. You can get it from this link:

<http://java.sun.com/products/jdk/1.1/download-jdk-windows.html>

Make sure to install JDK 1.1.8 in its default directory,

C:\JDK1.1.8\

If you are unable (for whatever reason) to install JDK 1.1.8 in its default directory, then you must edit the visual.bat file, located in the directory in which you installed Blanche.

The visual.bat file contains the following line:

```
c:\jdk1.1.8\bin\java -classpath .;c:\jdk1.1.8\lib\classes.zip;graphapplet.jar GraphApplet >
output.txt
```

You must change the underlined portion to the directory in which you have installed JDK 1.1.8.

Make sure your ModelBuilder and ModelAnalyzer shortcuts (.lnk files) have the Blanche program directory entered in the "Start in" field. For most users, this directory is:

"C:\Program Files\Blanche"

You need to put the path in quotes, unless you enter it this way:

C:\PROGRA~1\BLANCHE
